tex2xindy – a frontend to the **xindy** index processor

SYNOPSIS

tex2xindy [**file**]

DESCRIPTION

tex2xindy is a filter that reads from *stdin* a file in the input-format of the **makeindex** index processor. This format is usually located in a file with the extension **.idx**. **tex2xindy** reads in this format and converts it to a format suitable for the use with **xindy**.

If the optional argument 'file' is specified, tex2xindy puts some information into this file which is further processed by the makeindex4(1L) program. For more information have a look at the "Compatibility Guide" which explains this format. It is part of the xindy distribution.
